  - Engagement with ministers, senior officials, peak bodies, research organisations

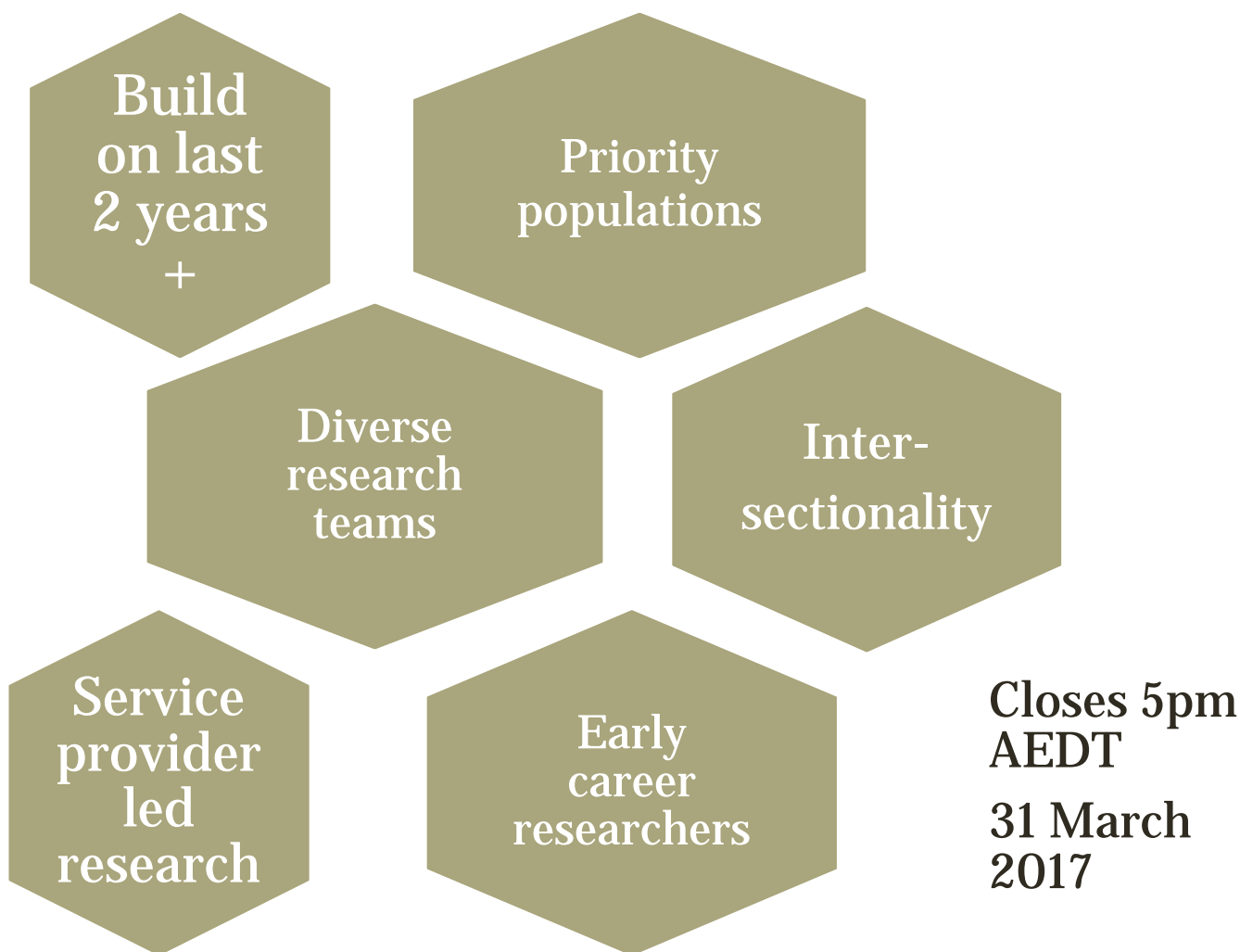
# Knowledge Production

Complex interactions between knowledge producers & users

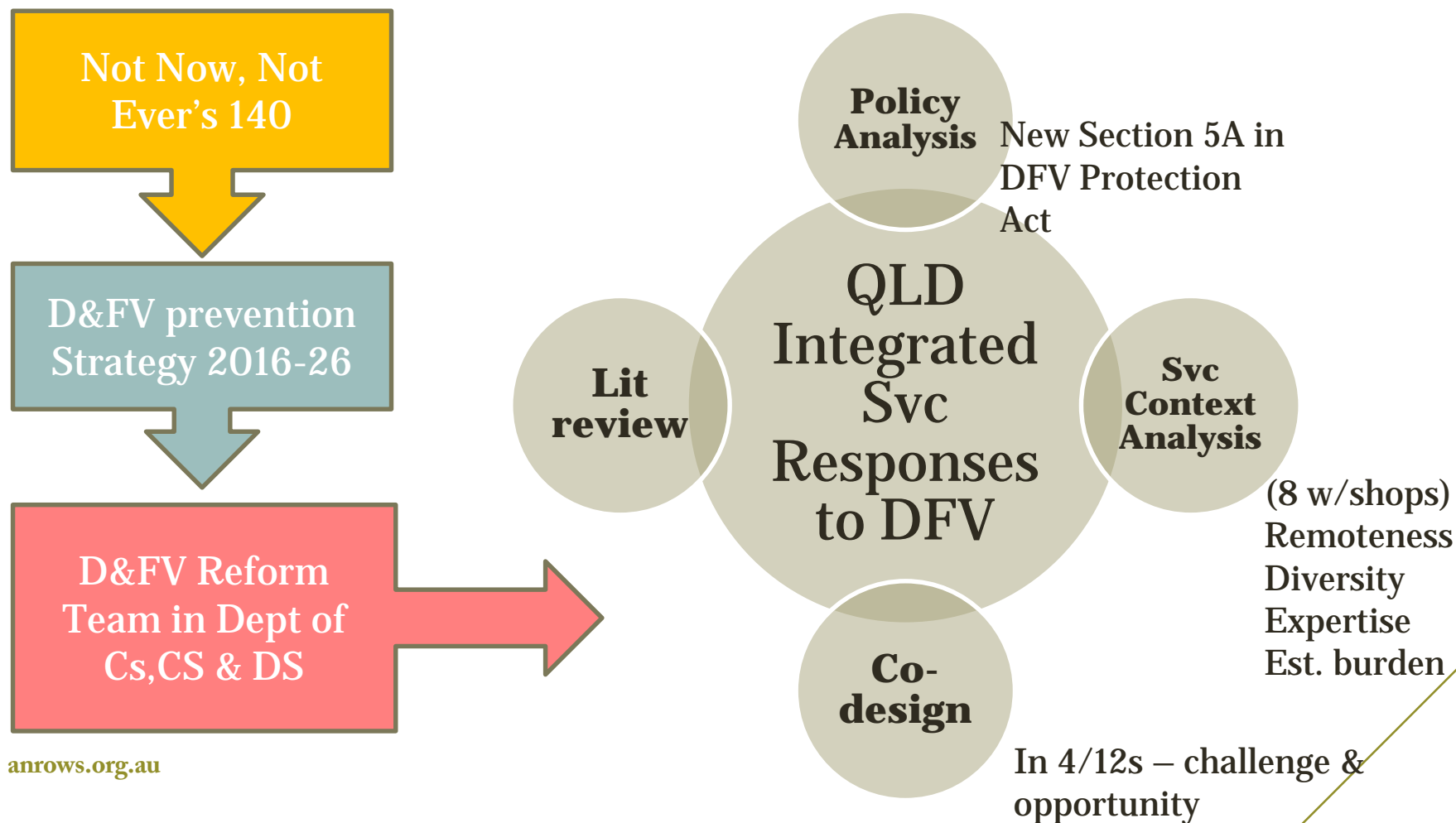

- Innovative suggestions are welcome

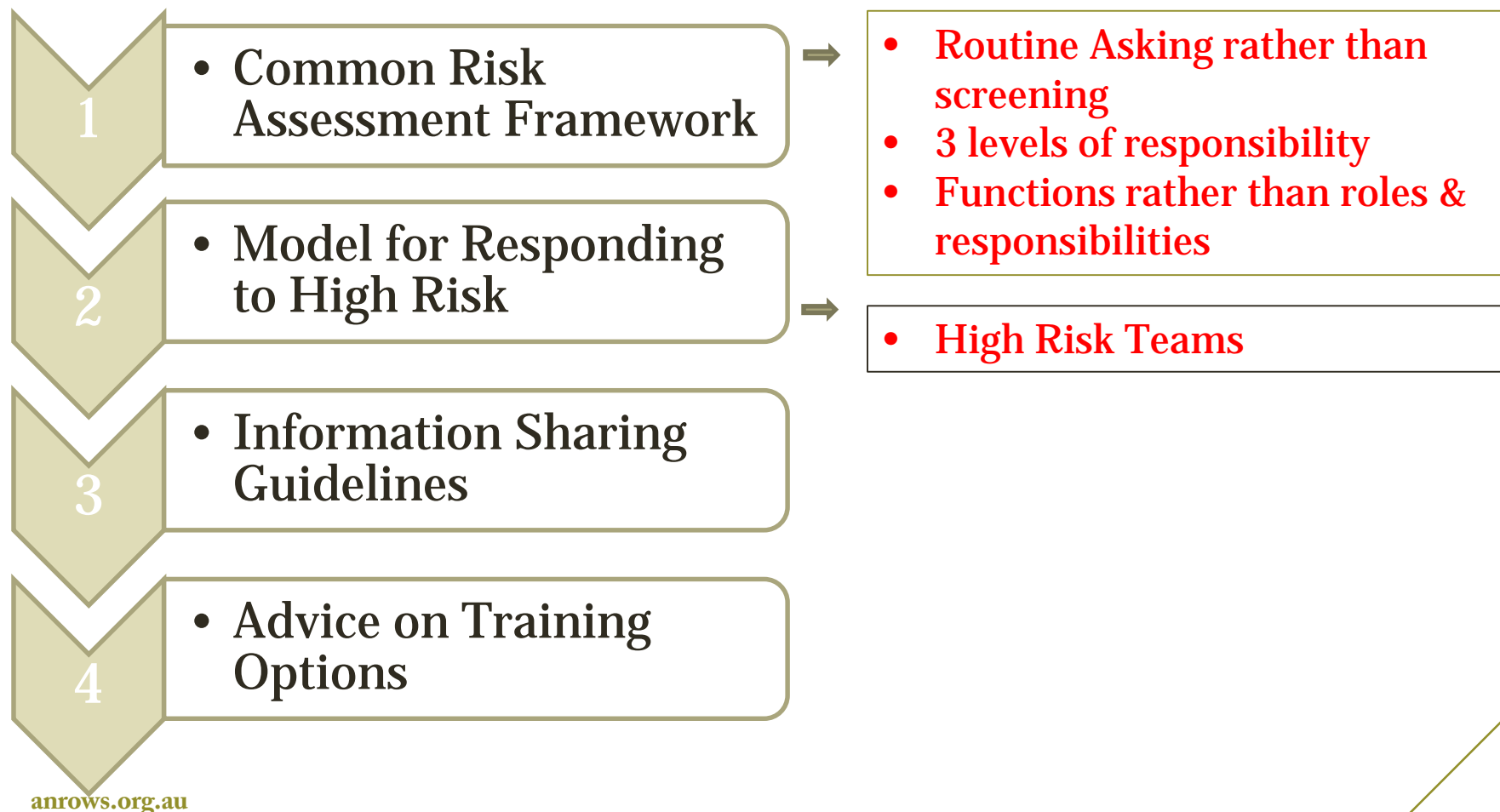

# Draft Framework

## Routine asking & referral lv 1

- Mainstream professionals and some community members
- **Routine asking**
- **Produces risk or no risk result**
- **Appropriate referral if risk is present**

## Risk assessment & safety action planning lv 2

- Prescribed govt agencies and specialist DFV\* providers (mandatory)
- Professionals from NGOs who have a role in responding to DFV (optional)
- **Assessment to determine whether high risk**
- **Safety Planning**
- **Referral to high risk team if appropriate**

## Multi-agency risk assessment & safety management lv 3

- Multi-agency high risk team
- **Complex risk assessment**
- **Safety planning & Safety Management**
- **DFV service response**
- **Case management.**
